Home School graduates - Same curriculum requirements as high school graduates. 2007 high school graduates - Must meet current state curriculum requirements. 2008-2010 high school graduates - Phase-in course requirements: Opportunity/Career - No phase-in; Curriculum required for high school graduation. Honors/Performance - 2008 graduates - Algebra I; one Science; 2009 graduates - Algebra I plus either Geometry or Algebra II; two Science; 1 Social Studies that covers American history; 2010 graduates - Algebra I & II and Geometry; 3 years of Science; 2 Social Studies that cover World History and American History; 1 year Foreign Language 2011 high school graduates - Must complete 'success curriculum'.
